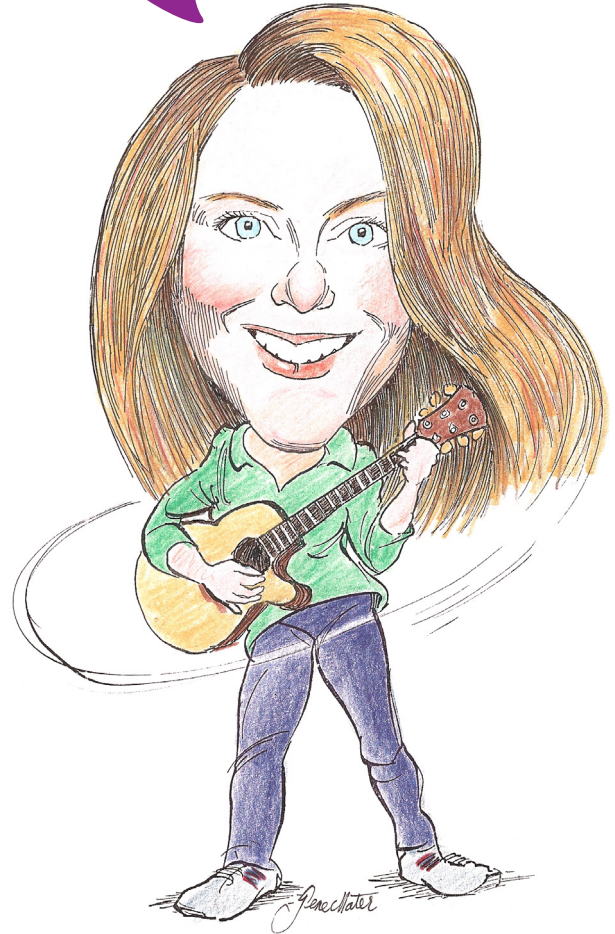


Peggy Gerner is Miss Maggie,

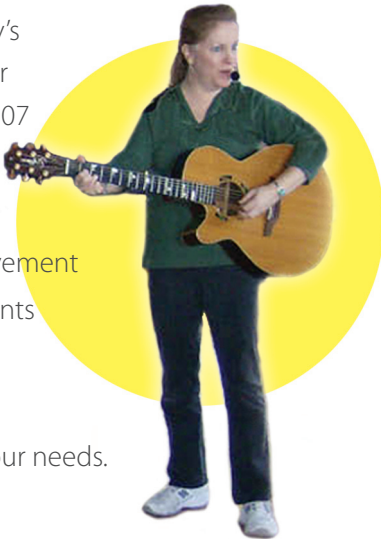
